WORDS FROM THE CEO

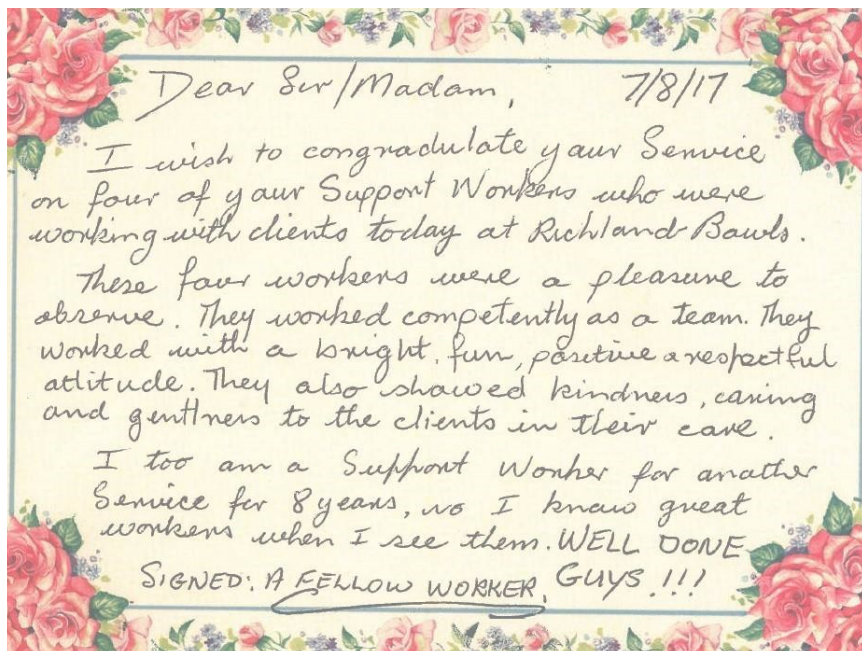

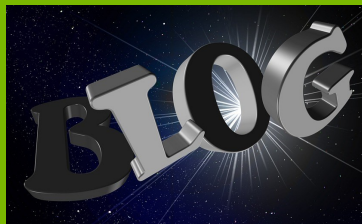

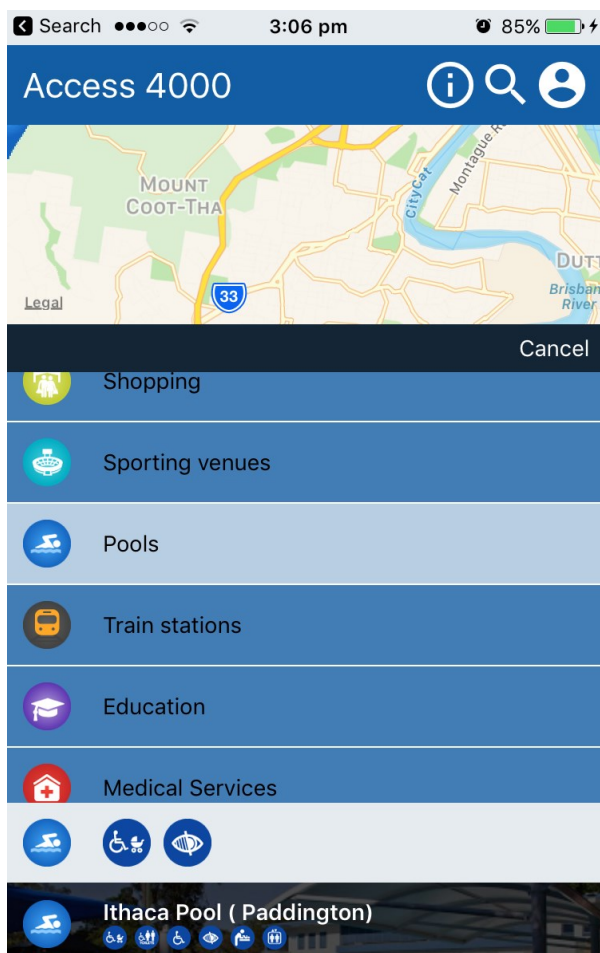
ACCESS 4000

Access 4000 is a revolutionary new smartphone app which is helping people with disability navigate their way around Brisbane in an Australian first.

The app highlights disability access features like wheelchair and pram ramps, disabled toilets and parking, and support for low vision or blindness.

Map-based technology then allows users to find venues around Brisbane with these features, including public transport, shopping centres and tourist attractions.

Access 4000 is currently available for free on the App Store and Google Play.

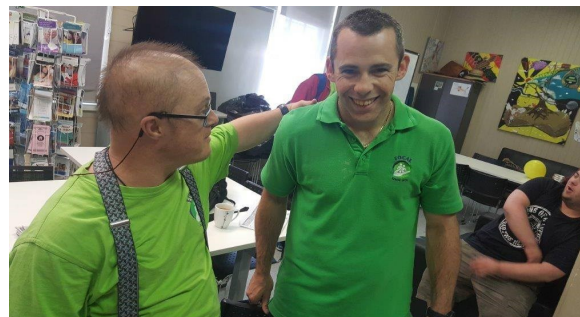


CLIENT & STAFF NEWS

FOCAL ENTERPRISE: NATIONAL RECYCLING WEEK
