Hello Everyone,

Since joining FOCAL in my role as CEO in June 2016, I have made it a priority to provide clarity and transparency to our members, participants, staff and

volunteers. I have had the opportunity to meet many of you personally at the special members meeting held on 3<sup>rd</sup> July and continue to be introduced to new people on a daily basis.

I have been working with the FOCAL Management Team to build more flexibility and recognises that economic participation of simplify our processes to ensure we can dedicate maximum time and resources to our clients. In the coming months, my focus will be on a number of different items. Internally, we are continuing research on new opportunities. Particular attention will be on building a clear strategic map for the organisation in the transition towards the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) next year. We are

actively preparing to ensure a seamless transition for both participants and staff.

Externally, the team is developing new connections and reinforcing the FOCAL presence both locally and in South East Queensland. We are exploring how FOCAL can play a more integral role in supporting our participants with housing and accommodation and to this end, a consultation has been scheduled for Thursday 25th August at 6:00pm. In addition to accommodation, FOCAL people with a disability needs to be addressed and it is anticipated that another consultation focussing on employment is be scheduled for 15th September 2016 at 6:00pm.

#### Your Privacy - What you can expect at FOCAL

All staff at FOCAL have an important role in ensuring the privacy and confidentiality of information relating to clients, families and colleagues is always maintained. Some ways FOCAL meets this requirement includes:

- Providing staff with training about what is expected
- Supporting clients and families to understand their rights and what to expect
- Only collecting information that we need to provide services
- Ensuring personal information is not shared with others unless consent has been given
- Maintaining security of electronic and paper personal records and not leaving information out for others to see eg. on desks
- Supporting individuals to make a complaint if they have any concerns about FOCAL's privacy practices or handling of their personal information
- Destroying personal information when it is no longer required. This is to be done in a secure manner (eg. by disposing of it in the assigned bin)

### FOCAL Vacation care Visit By Janelle Lind (aka Skittles or Troll)



On Thursday the 7th July 2016, members of the Lockyer and Ipswich Ulysses branches (plus one friend) gave up their time to either show their bikes off or give rides at FOCAL's Vacation Care Program.

Firstly, on behalf of FOCAL, Kerri Siebenhausen (Out of School Hours Care Coordinator), and Elise Campbell (2IC Senior Vacation Care), Support Staff and especially the children, we wish to say "a very BIG THANK"

-YOU for such generous support to the Vacation Care Program".

In total (if I counted right) we had 18 bikes come along—1 Trike, 3 x Can AM Spyders and 14 x 2 Wheelers. It was amazing to even hear them arrive let alone see them all parked.

The anticipation of the bike event had been building from the first day of the school holidays (the week before), so the excitement really amped up once the bikes actually arrived. A few of the children were quite hesitant at first, but in the end we couldn't keep them away, and everyone finished up going for not just one but two rides. Some were just shaking with excitement!. They were packed with emotions - smiles you could



see for miles. For some it was a dream come true. Immediately the children were asking "Can they come back?" When are they coming back?" "Can they come in September school holidays?" So it's safe to say, they really loved the whole experience.

Out of all the children there were about 3 that did not want to or could not go on the bikes, however staff made sure that they could see the parked bikes from the room or visit the parked bikes, and have a look/listen/feel of the different bikes on display. One young person in particular comes to mind. He really loved the feel of the Fox Tail, enjoying the sensory experience. I could see his smile from 20 metres away. For those children that were not so strong in the core area, were able to put them onto the Spyder, with a staff member and the rider on either side. As you can imagine it was really hard to talk the staff into assisting, NOT!!! In fact several staff finished up having a turn on the Spyder's, without a child. We call it staff

participation.

It really was a terrific event, there was tons of enthusiasm and excitement and lot's of FUN was had by all....

- Days at the Horizons Program for people with high support needs
- Assistance at work
