The 2016-17 year has been one of the most significant in Focal's 44 year history, since the de-institutionalisation at the end of the '70s, or the implementation of the disability pension, strongly influenced by our very own former President, Jim Cummings OAM. Indeed, with the launch of the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) on May 26, 2017, the Focal environment has changed dramatically—with some fantastic outcomes for clients and families.

Through 2016-17, Focal has focused on supporting clients, their families and carers, and the community in general to get 'NDIS ready'. This work continues with Focal's transitioned clients, and will progress to ensure that the community gets the best outcome from the NDIS.

2017-18 promises to be a fascinating year for Focal, with many new surprises and initiatives in store. We will continue to increase our community consultations, with the aim of co-designing activities that ensure all the current needs and expectations of our clients are being met. The year will also see a greater focus on health and wellbeing, to address a growing need that has been expressed by our parents and participants.

Focal is also looking to implement new social enterprise initiatives, for those who want to participate in activities and give back to the community. Moreover, Focal will continue to increase options for families wishing to foster independence. This includes additional 24/7 services, independent living solutions and alternative respite arrangements.

2016-17 has been a fantastic year for Focal's Out of School Hours Care Services. The children and staff had lots of fun participating in a whole range of unique and exciting experiences throughout the year. In addition to our regular Vacation and After School Care activities, we offered some new activities for children to participate in, including a Helicopter visit and visit from the RSPCA.

With the NDIS now rolled out in the Ipswich region, we have seen families extend their support from services such as Vacation and After School Care, to individualised in-home and community access supports. Despite the impact that the NDIS has had on the costing of our services, we remain committed to providing quality support for children and young people into the future.



Because of the NDIS, Focal is launching a new school holiday club in December, named **'The Fab Focal Club'**. This service is specifically designed for NDIS-approved participants aged 13-17, who have standard intensity support requirements. The purpose of this club for teenagers is to develop everyday life skills, build friendships and have fun!

Participants will undertake a range of fun and exciting experiences over the three weeks, including outings to the cinema, Orion Lagoon and Wivenhoe Dam, as well as cooking, art & craft and games days.
